### **Purpose**

To identify under what circumstances Parking Meter Exemption Permits may be issued by the City.

### **Policy Statement**

1. Exemption Permits for Parking Anytime may be issued to members of Council who hold a valid Driver's Licence and possess a personal vehicle. Only one permit per Councillor and Mayor, capable of being transferred between vehicles.
2. Parking Exemption Permits while on City business 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. may be issued under the following:
  - (a) one per unmarked City vehicle as required by the Director of a Department;
  - (b) one per employee who is compensated for using his/her vehicle while on City business;
  - (c) one per unmarked vehicle registered to the St. John's Regional Fire Department as requested by the Fire Chief;
  - (d) one per unmarked vehicle registered to the St. John's Transportation Commission as required by the Manager.

3. Exemption Permits are not required for vehicles identified as being owned by the City, St. John's Regional Fire Department, or the St. John's Transportation Commission.

#### **OUTSIDE AGENCIES**

1. That only persons entitled to receive permits under the provisions of the Bylaw, be issued them.

2. That a fee of \$100.00 per Exemption Permit apply; where such permits are issued to doctors or persons with medical disabilities.
